



UDUK SAFEGUARDING POLICY – AUGUST 2023

SAFEGUARDING POLICY

1. Players and spectators must be 18 years of age or older to take part in or to observe UDUK league matches and events.
2. Players should not drink to excess. Players have a duty of care to themselves, each other and to the environments that they are playing in.
3. All players should act responsibly, as per the UDUK matchday charter, and endeavour to look out for each other.
4. All players should familiarise themselves with UDUK's inclusivity policy, found on the UDUK website. Players should be proactive in reporting violations of this policy.
