Once signed, both captains should photograph the sheet. One of the **HOME** captains must promptly upload the sheet via uduk.co.uk.

RULES

- CAPTAINS BULL-OFF** – Home Captain will throw for the Bull first. Winning team will throw first in the first leg of sets T1, S1, S3, S5, D1, D3, S8, S10, S12. Please mark who has the throw in each set with a *. Throw alternates each leg.
- EXTENDED FORMAT** – The extended 6v6 format should be played when **BOTH** universities have only one team. It should not be played otherwise, except possibly for internal A v B games, with both captains in agreement. Extended format score-lines will be scaled to standard format values.
- ELIGIBLE PLAYERS** – Only current university students and 2022 graduates are permitted to play. Captains can request to see a form of valid student ID if they believe an opposition player to be ineligible. Representatives from universities who wish to field university staff must contact the committee for approval. Please use a player's full name on the match sheet.
- SCORING** – The **HOME** team should provide someone to mark each game where possible and marking should be done on a whiteboard / chalkboard in full view of both teams. Use of a scoring app is only permitted in circumstances where a whiteboard / chalkboard is not available. In this scenario, please ensure the score on the app is in full view of both teams.

On your turn to throw, please wait until the person marking has confirmed your score prior to removing your darts from the board. If you feel a score may have been marked incorrectly for either team, you may only challenge this prior to your next throw.
- RESPONSIBILITY** – Players, Captains & Supporters have a responsibility to act safely, appropriately and to always represent university darts in a positive manner, including when travelling to matches and at match venues. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action and your society's UDUK membership being revoked.
- RESPECT** – University darts is intended to be enjoyable for all, regardless of ability. Please treat other players with respect and shake hands before and after each set, no matter the result.
